What is NUST Library Catalogue (ENCORE)?

The NUST Library Catalogue is the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) that enables you to do searches and see what resources are available in the Namibia University of Science and Technology Library. Searches can be done from any workstation or PC where you have Internet access.

You can access the ENCORE from the Library website under library resources.

STEPS:

- Go to the NUST library website <u>http://www.nust.na/?q=library</u>
- Under Library resources, click on NUST Library Catalogue (ENCORE)
- Scroll down the page and you will see an explanation of the terms used in the online catalogue e.g.

 - OS Open Shelf
 - IS Issued
 - RE Renewed
 - LO Long Overdue
 - IP In Process (the item has been bought but is not yet on the shelf).
